### (2) Emergency Calls

### O Police

If you are involved in an accident or a criminal incident, call 110.

A police officer will ask you the following questions on the phone. Answer the questions slowly and clearly. After hanging up, wait by the phone until the police arrive.

[Six Questions]

- ① 「What happened?」 [(In Japanese) Nani ga arimashita ka?]
  - $\Rightarrow$  An accident **[Jiko]** (traffic accident)
  - $\Rightarrow$  A crime **[Jiken]** (violence, robbery)
- ② 「Where did it happen?」 [Doko de arimashita ka?]
- ③ 「When did it happen?」 [Itsugoro arimashita ka?]
  - $\Rightarrow$ (The time when the incident happened)
- ④ 「What are the features of the suspect?」 [Hannin no tokucho wa?])
- ⑤ 「What is the present situation?」 [Ima dounatte imasu ka?]
- (6) [What is your name and telephone number?][Anata no namae to renraku no toreru denwabango wa?]

## O Fire fighting

Call 119 in case of fire or medical emergency.

【How to call 119】

- (1) A dispatcher will ask whether you are reporting a fire or requesting an ambulance
- Fire  $\Rightarrow$  "A fire" [(In Japanese) Kaji Desu]
- Medical emergency or an accident
  - $\Rightarrow$  "An ambulance, please." [Kyukyusha ga hitsuyou desu]
- ② Give the location of the emergency, your name, and the phone number where you can be reached.
- ③ Explain the situation.
- Fire  $\Rightarrow$  What is burning? Is anybody injured? Is anybody left behind or inside?
- •Medical emergency  $\Rightarrow$ Briefly convey the state of injury or symptoms.
- 4 If someone is with you, go outside to help emergency vehicles find the place.
  - X You can call 119 not only in Japanese but also in languages such as English, Chinese, Korean, Portuguese and Spanish through multilingual operators.
