# 2-2 Procedures about Daily Life

# (1) Housing

## O Public Housing

Osaka Prefecture and Toyonaka City provide housing with comparatively low rents to low-income people who have difficulties finding affordable housing. As there are many applicants for the limited number of housing units available, occupants are almost always determined by lottery.

### O Private Housing

It is common to find a house or an apartment through real estate agents. They will give you information and show you the places free of charge. If you decide on a house you want to live in, pay commissions to the agent and make a lease contract with the landlord. There are Japan-specific systems such as Shiki-kin (refundable deposit) and Rei-kin (non-refundable key money).

### [Guarantee of lease obligation of the Foundation for Senior Citizens' Housing]

This is a system to assist international households to rent housing by guaranteeing the payment of the rent debt at the time of moving into private housing.

# [Comprehensive Renters Compensation Program for Foreign Students Studying in Japan of Japan Educational Exchanges and Services]

This is a system to provide a guarantee to foreign students and their guarantors to enable foreign students to move into private housing by reducing the burden on their guarantors in the tenancy agreement.

This is a combination of the traveler's insurance and guarantee compensation foundation.

They compensate in case a student is charged for loss because of fire, etc. or when a guarantor is called upon by the landlord to pay the rent debt.

## O Water -Including Sewage

#### [Applying for Water Service]

Give your name and address to the Waterworks Bureau about one week before moving in.

#### [Payment of Water and Sewage]

You can choose the way from account transfer, payment slip, and continuous credit card payment.

For account transfer, apply at a financial institution window or by mail to the Waterworks and Sewerage Bureau. Please see the Waterworks and Sewerage Bureau website for how to apply.

With your payment slips, please pay at a financial institution's window, a convenience store, or by smartphone payment. For credit card payment, you can apply on the Waterworks and Sewerage Bureau website.

#### O Waste

#### [Daily Waste]

Please put out your waste in Toyonaka City designated garbage bags.

Garbage needs to be separated. The collection days of each kind of waste vary depending on the address.

#### [Oversized Waste and Special Pickups]

A fee is required to dispose of oversized waste (furniture, electric appliances, etc.) and a large amount of waste due to moving house (special pickups). In addition, a reservation is required for the collection.

# [Permission to Engage in an Activity other than that Permitted under the Status of Residence Previously Granted]

Foreign nationals with a status such as "study" or "dependent" may work and receive income if they obtain a "permission to engage in an activity other than that permitted under status of residence previously granted". If foreign nationals who graduated from universities in Japan search for a job with resident status of "specific activity (searching for job)" and apply for that with a recommendation letter from their university, they will also get the permission.

#### O Driver's License

#### [International Driver's License]

The international driver's license, acquired before your arrival in Japan, is valid for 1 year from the issue date. This license must have been issued by the administrative office of a country that is a member of the Geneva Convention. Please be aware that some countries' licenses may not be able to be used in Japan.
