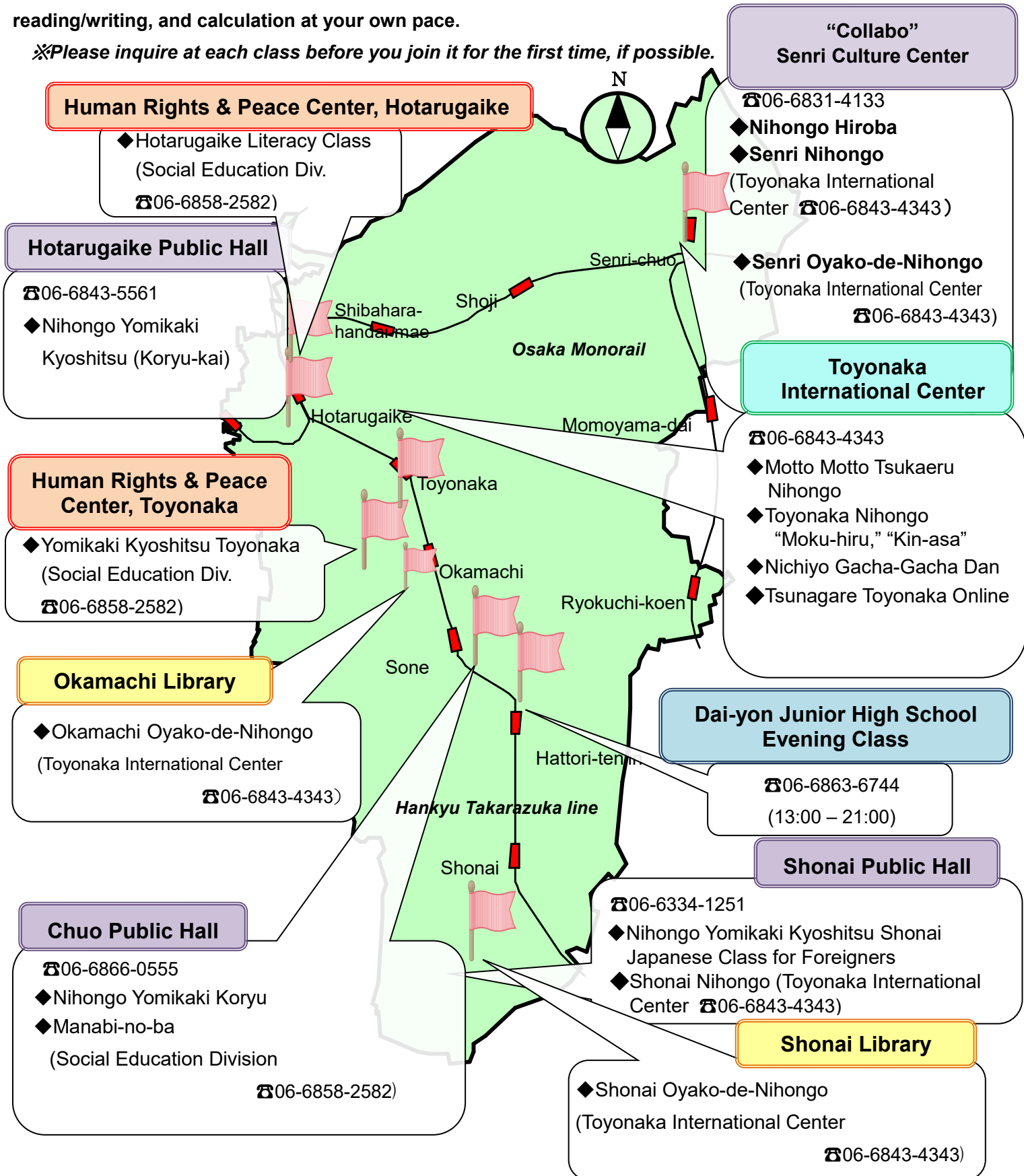


Courses mainly on basic levels where you can learn Japanese including essential daily conversation, reading/writing, and calculation at your own pace.
