Toyonaka, a city that developed early as a suburban residential area within the Osaka metropolitan area. Beloved by its citizens as a bustling and relaxing place, such as Senri New Town, Hattori Ryokuchi, Honan Market, and the Romantic Road.

Toyonaka City is renowned as a city filled with music. It is rich in musical resources, for example Osaka College of Music and the Japan Century Symphony Orchestra, with various music events are also held throughout the city.

On the other hand it is also the birthplace of high school sports in Japan, hosting the first national tournaments for baseball, soccer, and rugby. Sports facilities abound, including Toyonaka Rose Stadium, which hosts official professional baseball games, and Fureai Ryokuchi, equipped with a pool, tennis courts, and sports ground.

Moreover, excellent transportation access is a major appeal of Toyonaka City. It is conveniently connected to Kansai's gateway to the skies, Osaka International Airport, and features rail lines including the Hankyu Railway, Osaka Monorail, and Kita-Osaka Kyuko Railway, making transfers easy. Furthermore, major highways like the Meishin Expressway, Chugoku Jukan Expressway, and Shin-Midosuji are well-developed, making it a very convenient city for travel throughout the Kansai region.

Senrigawa Embankment, known as a mecca for airplane photography. Airplanes fly overhead. This spectacular sight makes it a popular spot beloved by many people. The right side of this Senrigawa Embankment has been developed, allowing visitors to sit and watch the planes. Then, on August 12, 2025, part of Toyonaka Tsubasa Park "ma-zika" has been opened adjacent to the Senrigawa Embankment. True to its name, this new attraction offers an up-close experience with airplanes. The covered observation deck allows people to watch planes comfortably even rainy and hot days. Full opening is scheduled for March 2027, featuring a dog run, playground, barbecue area, and a market plaza where visitors can enjoy food, drinks, and local products. Additionally, the left side of Senrigawa Embankment is slated for development by fiscal 2029, including a grassy plaza and waterfront embankment.

Hattori Ryokuchi, one of the largest parks in Osaka Prefecture. This historical park was also selected as a candidate site for the 1970 Osaka World Expo. With approximately 7 million visitors annually, it is popular as a place of relaxation and exchange in Toyonaka City. The grounds have various facilities, for example an outdoor music hall, an athletic field, and a swimming pool. Since 2023, new facilities like cafes and futsal courts have been opened under the theme of "Wellness for Mind, Body, and Society," further broadening its appeal.
